This Indenture, Between, Mattie G. Farmer, the Lessor and Mattie Sullivan the Lessee, Witnesseth: That the Lessor agrees to lease to the Lessee the tract of land situate in said County, containing Forty four and one half acres, known as the Goldsmith Farm place in Butlertown Township, Greenville County, for agricultural purposes.

Lease.

To hold the same to the Lessee from the first day of January 1932, to the thirty-first day of December 1933.

And the lessee on his part agrees to pay to the Lessor, as rent for the same fifteen hundred pounds of lint cotton, of all the cotton, corn, fodder, cotton seed, wheat and everything grown on the place with shall become due as soon as gathered, and said Cotton to be sold by tenant and proceeds delivered to Lessor no later than October 15, of each year 1932, and 1933.
