Whereas, under and by virtue of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, approved the 10th day of March 1928, the duty of the Sheriff of Greenville County with reference to the collection of delinquent taxes was conferred upon the delinguent tax collector, who has been duly appointed and qualified by law and is now discharging all of the duties required by said Act; and

Whereas, there appears on the Tax Duplicate of Greenville County for the fiscal year commencing January 1st, 1927, 1928, and 1929, certain real estate consisting of all that piece parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, being Lot #182, of Traxler Park as shown by plat, being the same lot conveyed to Ruth R. Walker by Realty Corporation and recorded in R. M. C. office of Greenville County in Volume 80 at page 72, assessed in the name of Ruth R. Walker and valued at Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), the taxes penalties and assessments thereon amounting to Thirty Five & 03/100 Dollars, (35.03) and,

Whereas, the above named Ruth R. Walker having neglected to pay the County Treasurer of Greenville County the above taxes assessments and penalties as prescribed by law, executions were issued therefor as directed bysaid Acts, on the 16th day of March 1928, the First day of May 1929, and the First day of May 1930, and lodged with the Tax Collector of Greenville County; and,

and 03/100 Dollars, good and lawful money of the United States, to me in hand paid by the said Mary G. Traxler (a receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) having granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Mary G. Traxler, Lot #128, of Traxler Park as shown in Volume #80, at page 72, recorded in R. M. C. office of Greenville, South Carolina, which record see for metes and

· Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or apportaining.

To have and to hold, all and singular the premises hereby granted, with the appurtanances, unto the said Mary G. Traxler, her heirs and assigns, forever, according to the form, force and effect of the laws and usages of the State of South Carolina in such cases made and provided.
