(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. Grady Neely,

All my right, title and interest the same being a one-half undivided interest of all real estate owned by my late mother, Mrs. Etta Neely, at the time of her death, as the widow of the late W. R. Neely, or through or under the deeds from myself and my brother, W. Grady Neely, to her, and also my right, title and interest in and to the real estate owned by my late father, W. R. Neely, the same having been enjoyed by my mother in her dower in his estate, it being the purpose of this deed and the intention of the said Ralph B. Neely to convey all his right, title and interest of whatsoever nature in the real estate owned by both his father, W. R. Neely and his mother, Mrs. Etta Neely, to the said W. Grady Neely, his heirs and assigns forever, so that with the deed heretofore made by the said Ralph B. Neely to the said W. Grady Neely, the said W. Grady Neely will be the absolute owner in fee of all real estate of which his late father, W. R. Neely died seized or possessed or in any way interested.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W. Grady Neely, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I, myself and my do hereby bind heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. Grady Neely,

his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
