to Frances Caldwell in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Dollars,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Frances Caldwell her heirs and assigns:

All our respective undivided right, title, interest, and estate or, in and to that certain lot of land with the improvements thereon, in the Town of Greer, said County and State, having a frontage of twenty-three (23) feet on Trade Street, with a uniform width of twenty-three feet to a depth of one hundred (100) feet, containing 2,300 square feet, more or less, and bounded (formerly) by lands of M. L. Merchant and/or the estate of G. W. Biggs, deceased, later said to belong to Greer, and/or others; being conveyed to Clarence Sexton and A. C. Sexton by T. W. Coe by deed dated November 9, 1901, being recorded in R. L. C. Office in Vol. 1,000, p. 229, and conveyed to M. D. Littlefield by deed of J. Inman, Lester for Greenville County, Recorded in Vol. 153, at page 31.

Also all our respective undivided right, title, interest and estate, present and future, or, in and to that certain tract of land about one-half mile northwest of the town of Greer, Chick Springs Township, said County and State, containing seventy-two (72) acres, more or less, and bounded (now or formerly) by lands of Lawrence Jones, Thomas Grove, Hartley Sherman, G. W. Ballenger Estate and others, and Beginning at a Hickory on the road leading along the eastern line of the farm and running thence N. 62° W. 32.34 ons. to a stone; thence S. 1-1/3 W. 26.88 ons. to a stake; thence S. 88-2/3 E. 18.83 ons. to a stake; thence S. 7.15 W. 6.37 ons. to a stake; thence S. 78 W. 13.75 ons. to stake in road leading out; from Broadus Street; thence along said road N. 4 1/3 E. 33.04 ons. to the beginning corner, according to plat made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, May 30th, 1927, being a portion of the real estate devised to Hattie A. Ashmore by the will of John D. Ashmore, Apr. 20th, 1925, Probate Judge's office this County, and conveyed to M. D. Littlefield by the deed of said Hattie A. Ashmore recorded in Vol. 126, page 289.

Also, all our right, title and interest in and to that certain lot of land, with the improvements thereon, in the town of Greer, said County and State, being on the south side of Emma Street, beginning on O. P. Smith's corner and running thence with Emma Street, one hundred and five (105) feet to T. M. Hill's corner; thence with T. M. Hill's line back, two hundred and ten (210) feet to J. T. Wood's line; thence with J. T. Wood's line one hundred and five (105) feet to O. P. Smith's corner; thence with O. P. Smith's line two hundred and ten (210) feet to the beginning corner, and containing 2,080 square feet, more or less, and bounded on the North by Emma Street; and (now or formerly) East by T. M. Hill; South by J. T. Wood and West by O. P. Smith; and being tract No. 2 conveyed to M. D. Littlefield by deed of Annie S. Littlefield recorded in Vol. 85, page 221.

Also, our right, title, interest and estate or, in and to that certain lot of land in Chick Springs Township, said County and State, beginning at an iron pin on the southeastern corner of the N. E. Bright tract, of the A. S. Grove corner, and running thence along the line between N. E. Bright and M. D. Littlefield, N. 62° W. 6.91 ons. to an iron pin in said road; thence N. 11° E. 16.8 feet to new road; thence along the edge of the road and down the same 471 feet to the beginning corner, being a small triangular lot out of from what is known as the N. E. Bright farm, according to survey and plat by W. E. Christother January 7th, 1921, and is for the purpose of giving to the tract of M. D. Littlefield a front on the new road, and being all which was owned by the said N. E. Bright on the south side of the said road, according to said plat. The above triangle is the same conveyed to M. D. Littlefield by deed of N. E. Bright recorded in Vol. 136, at page 442, and joins the tract described in Vol. 128, page 289.

Also that lot of land in "Needmore" near the town of Greer, Chick Springs Township, said County and State, known as the Benedict Lot, with any improvements thereon, being on the west side of Spring Street, and beginning at an iron pin, Henderson's corner, on said Street, and thence with Henderson's line northerly 135 feet to corner on the Thompson line; thence with the line of Thompson and/or McMakin 170 feet, more or less, to an iron pin or stake on an unnamed Street; thence with said unnamed Street 141 feet, more or less, to intersection with Spring Street; thence with Spring Street southerly 175 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, and being a part of the lands conveyed by W. E. Morrow to M. D. Littlefield, recorded WWW, page 240.

Also, that lot of land in "Needmore", said Township, County and State, on the east side of Spring Street, and beginning at iron pin, Barton's corner, on said Spring Street, thence south-easterly 203 feet, more or less, to point on Dobson line; the same with Dobson line S. 8-08 W. 80 ft. to the Mitchell corner; thence with Mitchell line in a general western direction 201 feet, more or less, to iron pin on Spring Street; thence with Spring Street northerly 80 feet to the point of beginning, and being part of the lands leased by W. E. Morrow to M. D. Littlefield, recorded WWW, page 240.
