in the P. M. C. office for said County until July
19th, 1927, and whereas, in the meantime the
said Allen J. Abraham did execute a deed of assign-
ment of all of his property, real and personal, for
the ~~the~~ benefit of his creditors unto George
Norwood, F. H. Symmes, B. C. Keen and H. C. Beacham,
as assignees, and whereas all of said assignees
at the time of the execution of said deed of
assignment, and for many years before, had
full knowledge that the said property belonged to,
and was in possession of Camp perdown Mills,
and whereas the said assignees have never claimed
any right, title or interest in said lot of land,
and therefore, to wit, all men by these presents
that in consideration of the premises and of the
sum of Five (5) Dollars to us in hand paid,
we, the said George Norwood, F. H. Symmes, B. C. Keen
and H. C. Beacham, as assignees of Allen J. Abraham
do hereby declare that we have no title or interest
in the said lot of land and do hereby convey and
quit-claim unto the said Camp perdown Mills
any right or title which we, as assignees or
otherwise, may have in said lot of land, being
the same lot of land situate in the City, County
and State aforesaid, on the South Bank of the
Ready River and more fully described in the
said deed from Allen J. Abraham to Camp perdown
Mills, which is recorded in the P. M. C. office
for Greenville County in Volume 1267 page 132,
together with all rights and easements connected
therewith.
