



An Agreement, made and entered into this 15th
 day of ~~Nov~~ 1927, by and between
 Southern Railway Company, a corporation organ-
 ized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of
 the State of Virginia, hereinafter for convenience
 styled the Railway Company, party of the first part; and
~~Greene~~ ^{Greeneville} Sewer District Commission,
 a corporation ^{organized and} existing under and virtue of the laws of
 the State of South Carolina, hereinafter for convenience
 styled the Licensee, party of the second part;

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Witnesseth:
 That the Railway Company, for and in consid-
 eration of the covenants of the Licensee upon its
 part to be kept and performed, as hereinafter
 expressed, hereby gives and grants unto the
 Licensee the right or license, determinable as
 hereinafter expressed, to construct and maintain
 a twenty-one (21) inch vitrified clay sewer pipe
 across the right of way and under the spur
 track of the Railway Company serving the Piedmont
 Bonded Warehouse and Commission Company, at
 a depth of at least ten (10) feet below the base
 of the rails on said track, at Greenville, in the
 County of Greenville and State of South Carolina,
