Know All Men By These Presents: That I, L. B. Houston, Trustee for J. W. Norwood, E. A. Gilfillin, and L. B. Houston of said County and State for and in consideration of the terms, conditions and privilege hereinafter expressed, and the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to me in hand paid by Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission of Greenville, S.C., the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract or lot of land situated in Greenvile Township, in said County and State bounded by lands of the Greenville and Northern Railway Company, Southern Public Utilities Company, Reedy River, A.S. New and others, and being the same property formerly belonging to Riverside Mill - and to construct, maintain in good repair and use in and through said premises, in a proper manner, with necessary apparatus and appliances such as machinery, air vents, manholes and every other necessary and proper attachment, pipe lines for sewerage purposes through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter in and upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon off said line, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe lines all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper operation of same.

It is understood and agreed that the easement herein granted shall extend throughout the property of the grantor about 590 feet, and shall be of such width as the grantor shall deem necessary for the purposes herein specified and that the damage for which Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission may be held liable shall be confined to that arising from the use of this strip only, and nothing beyond.

It is further agreed and understood that this easement is to be used only during the construction or repair of said pipe line and with the exception of the right of Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission, its successors and assigns, agents, servants and employees to inspect said pipe line and to enter at any point and make repairs, the owner has the same right as he now has to cultivate and use the land, provided however, this shall not apply to such part where the top of the pipe is less than eighteen (18) inches underground.

It is further agreed and as a part of the

consideration hereof that the grantor herein, his successors, heirs and assigns, may make taps or connections with said pipe lines at his expense provided, however, that such connections or taps be made only under the rules and supervision of the engineer representing Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission or their successors.

It is further agreed that the said Commission will reimburse the grantor any extra expense he shall be put to in erecting any building over said sewer line, which expense shall be due to the existence of said line, and makes necessary the extra expense in said building; the amount to be paid hereunder to be certified by the engineer of said Commission.

It is further agreed and understood that in case of future damage to crops or property due from accident in said pipe lines that Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission shall pay reasonable damage therefor.

The payment and privileges above specified are hereby accepted in full settlement of all claims and damages for said easement.
