nineteen hundred and twenty one, filed their
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County

demanding judgment in relation to the premises here
inafter mentioned and described; and the cause being
at issue, came on to be heard on the 29th day of
May 1923 and such proceedings were had therein
as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby
it was adjudged and decreed that the said premises
hereinafter mentioned and described, be con-
veyed by J. C. A. Payer, Clerk of Court in and for the
County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes
