

State of South Carolina,
County of Greenville.
This agreement between Elias Howard and Alex Anastos,
Witnesseth:
1. That said Howard does hereby agree to lease and rent
unto the said Anastos for the period of five years
consecutively when the building contemplated to be
built on the corner of West Washington and Echols Streets
in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, shall
have been finished, the same to be begun not later than
(August) 1, 1928, and reached by completion by September
1, if possible, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and
the rent payable at the rate of sixty (\$60) dollars a month
for said five years shall begin when the occupation
begins, and shall end five years after the date of
such occupation.
2. The building hereby leased is to be the corner store
room at said Echols Street, but fronting on West Wash-
ington Street, and also the second story above the
corner store room which shall be subdivided
and arranged suitably for a residence for the fam-
ily of said Anastos.
3. It is understood and agreed that the said An-
astos shall use and occupy said corner story
room for business as a lunch stand, lunch coun-
ter, fruit store, ice cream and cold drinks, and
other articles ordinarily and reasonably sold
in connection with such business, and he
shall not change his business substantially,
and the said Howard agrees that no lease shall
be made to any other tenant in said building,
which is to have two other story rooms, for the
purpose of enabling some other tenant to engage
in the same general business as the said Anas-
tos, who is to be protected against such other
tenants from unfair and unreasonable compe-
tition in the business above mentioned.
4. That lessor shall not assign nor sub-let said
premises without the written consent of lessee,
(and if lessor becomes bankrupt or is forced to
discontinue business by any proceedings, either
voluntary or involuntary, then this lease shall
terminate and the lessee may entry and take
possession); and the lessee shall take good care
of the premises, and of all water pipes, plumbing
and lighting fixtures, and of all glass and
other parts of the building, and shall be respon-
sible for the care or replacement of same, when

broken, destroyed or damaged by the negligence of
himself, his family or customers.
5. The store room hereby leased to the said Anastos
shall be eighteen (18) feet wide in the clear, fronting
on West Washington Street, and the rent of Sixty (\$60)
dollars shall be payable monthly in advance,
Witness my hand and seal at Greenville, South
Carolina, this the 17th day of July, A.D. 1928.
