all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about fourteen miles north of the City of Greenville on the North side of the Old Buncombe Road, adjoining lands of John Noble, Stephen Loftis and others and has the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone (formerly a post oak); thence N. 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 10.50 ohs.; thence S. 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 14.50 ohs. to a stake; thence S. 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 55.80 ohs. to a stone in old Buncombe Road; thence N. 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 5.86 to an angle in road; thence N. 60 E. 7.40 ohs. to angle in road; thence N. 41 E. 3.10 ohs. to angle in road; thence N. 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.49 ohs. to angle in road; thence N. 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.60 ohs. to angle in road; thence N. 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.89 ohs. to angle in road; thence N. 64 E. 5.00 ohs. to angle in road; thence N. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 5.69 ohs. to a stake on side of road on H.C.
