Railroad; thence along said railroad N. 76.50. 119.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 16.6. 597 feet to Lowndes Hill Road, thence with Lowndes Hill Road N. 79.6. 100 feet to the beginning corner, as shown by a plat made by H.
