 3. No liquor nor ardent spirits to be sold on the property.
 4. No residence shall be built on said lot to cost less than dollars but any person may use two or more lots, placing one residence thereon.
 5. No building shall be erected nearer the streets than the building line shown in plat which is feet from the streets facing residence.
 6. No use shall be made of the lot or any part thereof, which would constitute a nuisance or injure the value of any of the neighboring lots.
 7. The lay of the lots as shown on said plat shall be adhered to and to scheme of facing lots in any other direction than that shown on said plat shall be permitted
