C. M. Wingall that piece parcel or lot of land in Greenville Mountain, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

described in Schedule C, Saluda River Company Lake and in accordance with the plat made by C. M. Stevenson for Eugene G. Coker 1920. The following notes add bounds to west: Beginning at a stake in a branch joint corner of C. M. Wing and J. C. Faro and running thence with Faro line N 51-45 E 670 feet to a stake, thence continuing with Faro line S 57 E 1316.7 feet to an old stone corner, thence S. 37 W 627 feet to a stone, thence S. 37 W 387 feet to a stone on the bank of the Saluda River, thence along the river in a northerly direction along the contour line of said lake to where the branch empties into same, thence in a southwesterly direction along the contour line of said lake, thence in a northeasterly direction to the beginning corner containing 2.5 acres more or less, according to the plat hereto attached and made a part of this deed.
