and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.

Said transmission line to be located approximately where the stakes now stand.
