Esley Bridge to Anderson Road known as White Horse Road

and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises in proper manner with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliance, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon the said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other like obstructions that may, in any way endanger the proper operation of the same.
