thence: Wells Lane Road on the western side and on Bradley street on the eastern side.

and to construct and maintain in, upon and through and across the proper manner with poles, towers, wires and other necessary arms and appurtenances for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity together with the right in all times to enter upon the said premises for the purpose of erecting the said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut poles and to establish in said lines all trees and other like structures that may in any way obstruct the proper operation of the same.
