to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G. W. Stone.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

G. W. Stone
all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate,
lying and being in Austin Township, County
and State aforesaid, near the Laurens road, land
about one and one half miles north of the Town
of Simpsonville and, more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a stone on road leading from
Bethel road to Simpsonville G. W. Stone's confine and
running thence N. 28-30 W. 15-30 to a stone, thence
S. 1-45 E. 9-24 to st. - thence N. 28-30 E.

16-20 to iron pin in road. thence along the center
of the road S. 65-20 W. 6-58 to bend in road. thence
N. 75 W. 2-34 to point of beginning.

also all that other piece, parcel or tract of
land joining the above described tract and
having the following lines and bounds to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on line of the
above described tract and running thence S.
5-45 W. 3-00 to bend in a gully. thence S. 30 W. 1-00
to a bend. thence N. 75-45 W. 20-20 to bend.

thence N. 89 W. 1-45 to bend. thence S. 35 W. 1-35
to bend. thence S. 74-30 W. 1-05 to iron pin in center
of Laurens road. thence along Laurens road to Todd's
corner. thence along Todd's line N. 41-15 E. 10-62 to
point on line of the above described tract. thence
along said line N. 61-45 W. 3-20 to the beginning
corner.

The first described tract containing 14.66
acres more or less and the last containing 2.60
acres according to survey of the same by W. J.
Riddle Surveyor June 1902.

Said tracts being a portion of the same land
conveyed to the said J. M. P. Brown and J. A. Pollard
by deed of A. S. Huff and E. F. Rice said deed recorded
in Office of Register for said County in Vol 70 page
463 and later the interest of J. A. Pollard conveyed
to me by deed recorded in said office in Vol 73
Page 555.

The only condition of this deed is that the
grantee does not come in possession of the
land herein conveyed until Jan 1st, 1939.
