(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mammie A. Fulmer all that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, and in Austin Township, about one and one half miles north of the town of Simpsonville and more fully described as follows;

Beginning at an iron pin in the road at Painters corner and running thence N. 23-30 E. 13.00 chains to an iron pin, thence N. 30-10 E. 1.12 to an iron pin, thence N. 63-5 W. 13.54 to an iron pin, thence S. 29-42 W. 13.63 to a stone on the road, thence S. 44-45 E. 4.03 to a stone, thence S. 75 E. 2.37 to a bend in the road, thence S. 65-20 E. 6.58 to the beginning corner and containing eighteen and $\frac{3}{10}$ acres more or less, said land being a part of the same land conveyed to me deed of J. A. Pollard, dated March 16, 1923 and recorded in Office of R. M. C. in said County in Vol. 73 at page 555. Also see deed of C. G. Huff and C. F. Rice to J. A. Pollard and M. P.
