feet to a willow tree; thence S. 22 1/2 E. 278 feet to  
stake in branch; thence S. 17 7/8 W. 256 feet to a water  
tub; thence S. 100 E. 153 feet to a poplar; thence N.  
66 1/4 W. 207 feet to a stone; thence S. 57 1/2 W. 151 feet  
to a s. wood tree; thence N. 58 1/2 W. 693 feet to a  
table. Thence N. 24 1/2 E. 2079 feet to a stake in center
