Railroad, said iron pipe being 57.5 feet from the center of tract and running thence along line of Watson land and other land of W. C. Bain S. 55-58 N. 178.1 feet to iron pipe, thence still with Mr. Bain's land N. 45-26 W. 116.4 feet to stake on bank of branch, thence a traverse line down branch S. 34-30 E. 16.6.5 feet to bend, thence with old run of branch S. 49-30 E. 19.2 feet to stake in center of old run of branch and on right of way of P. & M. Railway, thence along said right of way 57.5 feet from the center of tract N. 47 E. 16.93 feet to the beginning, containing 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ acres, more or less.
