all that piece, parcel or lots of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All our right, title and undivided interest in and to that certain tract of land inherited by us from our father and mother, E. E. Chapman, deceased, and Mrs. Nancy E. Chapman, deceased, about nineteen (19) miles from the Court house on the West side of the Augusta Road, containing two hundred (200) acres, more or less, adjoining lands of P. M. Davenport and E. M. Blythe on the North, and on the southwest said by Mrs. P. M. Davenport; on the Southeast by Tripp land, on the East side by the Augusta Road and Traynham.

It is understood and agreed that the grantees herein are to each take a one-half undivided interest in the premises herein conveyed; that the grantee Mrs. Kara Chapman Campbell take the Southern portion of said two hundred acre tract on which there are two houses; and that grantee R. D. Chapman receive the Northern half of said land on which there is one house. The dividing line to be later established between the two tracts by a survey.
