(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*Calfay Humphrey and Emma Humphrey, their heirs
and assigns:*

All our right, title and interest into all
that certain lot of land situate in Ward Five of the
City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, called
North Calhoun Street and being designated as a
portion of Lot no 2 in the division of the Estate of
M. A. Hellmann, deceased.

Beginning at a stake on Calhoun Street
at the corner of lot formerly owned by E. S. Roundtree
and thence running with the line of Calhoun Street
S 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 46 feet to a stake; thence S 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 19 3 feet to
a stake; thence N 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ more or less to a
stake at the corner of E. S. Roundtree's lot; thence
along the line of that lot N 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 157 feet, more
