J. A. Bull:-

Our undivided one-half interest in and to all that tract of land situate in Butler Township, in the County and State aforesaid, on the South side of Rocky Creek and East side of Little Rocky Creek and has the following meter and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at a Birch 3X0 m on Rocky Creek, and thence up said creek as a line, with its meandering, to a corner in the fork of Rocky Creek and Little Rocky Creek; thence up Little Rocky Creek with its meandering, to a stone 3X N, Holly 3X0 m, down; thence S. 51 1/2 E. 13.50 to a stone 3X N m on old line; thence S. 76 E. 29.35 to stone 3X N m in P.O. stump 3X0; thence N. 15 1/2 E. 17.31 to stone 3X0 m; thence S. 42 1/4 E. 4.12 to stone 3X0 m; thence N. 24 E. 5.05 to a stone 3X0 m; thence N. 25 3/4 N. 5.54 to stone 3X0 m; thence N. 33 E. 25.20 to the beginning corner; containing one hundred and eighty-one acres, more or less, according to the plat of J. N. Southern, dated the first day of August, 1895.

Also our undivided one-half interest in and to all that tract of land in the same locality, beginning on Little Rocky Creek, at a stone 3X N m, Holly 3X0 m, down; and runs thence N. 58 N. 24.34 to Pine 3X N m; thence N. 47 1/4 N. 9.50 to stone 3X N m; thence N. 47 1/4 N. 15.30 to a stone 3X 3X 3X N m; thence S. 65 3/4 N. 20.00 to stone 3X N m; thence S. 29 N. 21.76 to stone 3X N m, on George Bramlett's line; thence S. 55 1/2 E. 20.30 to stone 3X N m, P.O. stump 3X0 m; thence S. 9 E. 12.80 to a stone 3X0 m; William and Manning Graham's corner; thence S. 12 1/3 E. 16.36 to stone 3X0 m; thence N. 62 1/2 E. 22.00 to maple 3X N m on Little Rocky Creek; thence down Little Rocky Creek with its meandering, to the beginning corner, containing two hundred and seven acres, more or less, according to plat of J. N. Southern, dated 1st day of August, 1895.

An undivided one-half interest in the above tracts of land have been inherited by the Executors herein from Sloan L. Stroud, being the same tract of land conveyed to James A. Bull and Sloan L. Stroud by Alice J. Elms, by deed dated November 14th, 1913, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 28, at page 221.
