W. G. Estates,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
in Ward One of the City of Greenville, on the northwest corner of N. Main Street and Park  
Avenue (formerly Carrier St.), containing 44/100 of an acre more or less, and having the  
following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of N. Main  
St. and Park Ave. (formerly Carrier St.) thence with N. Main St. N. 19 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 85 feet to an  
iron pin; thence N. 78 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 231 feet to an iron pin on 20 foot alley; thence with the alley  
S. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 85 feet to an iron pin on Park Ave. (formerly Carrier St.); thence with Park  
Ave. S. 78 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 222 feet to beginning corner, being lot No. 4 of lands of Wm. C. Cleveland,  
according to a survey made by John Dickerson and revised by J. N. Southern, D. S. and  
being the same lot of land heretofore conveyed to J. Thomas Arnold and J. W. Jersey and
