being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars
to me paid by the said Lewis Young

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Lewis Young,

All that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, in the City of Greenville; Beginning at a stake on corner of lot of Lewis Young on Elford Street about 26 feet from corner of Manley Street, thence in a southwesterly direction along said Young's line about 64 feet to post in rear corner on Valley thence along said alley about 54 feet in a southwesterly direction to stake on Manley Street, thence along Manley Street in a northwesterly direction about 64 feet to corner of Manley and Elford Streets; thence along Elford Street in a northeasterly direction to beginning.
