"All that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, in Ward One of the City of Greenville, fronting 57 feet on Pine Street and extending to rear about 85 feet to lot formerly owned by Mrs. Elizabeth Love, on the east adjoining lot formerly owned by Stephen King and separated from said lot by a fence now on dividing line, and on west by adjoining lot formerly owned by Patrick Tucker, and containing 5,200 square feet, more or less, being the same conveyed to Rosa Terrell by Wm. G. Sirrine by deed dated March 7, 1922, recorded in Book 78, page 406.
