"All that certain lot of land situate at the Southeast corner of the intersection of South Main and East Broad Streets, in the city of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having, according to a plat prepared by Daiton & Neves, Engineers, October, 1927, the following wates and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:
