 to me paid by the said Lottie Babb Waldrep.

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lottie Babb Waldrep the following described real estate.

"All that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located situate and being on the Laurens Road, just inside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and opposite plant formerly owned by Mc Gee Manufacturing Company, and shown on plat of R. C. Dalton, Engineer, dated July 1921, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on southside of said Laurens Road 114 feet 6 inches from the right of way of S. & W. C. Ry. and running thence with line of Lot of W. H. Green, said lot being purchased from W. H. Green by deed dated March 31, 1922, and recorded in office of R. M.
