in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00),

do give, grant, and convey unto Clara Rose Ludwick,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Clara Rose Ludwick, her heirs and assigns forever;

all our right title and interest in and to the following described real estate:

(1) All that certain lot of land in South Carolina, Greenville County, Greenville Township, being Lot #45 of North Cherokee Park, according to a plat recorded in Plat Book C, page 96, said lot having a frontage on Reovue Avenue of 60 feet and a depth of 17 1/2 feet to an alley in rear and is particularly described on said plat.

(2.) All that certain lot of land in the County and state aforesaid about 1 1/2 miles Southeast of Greenville Court House, being Lot #45 of North Cherokee Park, according to a plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, page 96; said lot has a frontage on Reovue Avenue of 60 feet and runs back to an alley a depth of 17 1/2 feet, as shown on said plat, and is a part of the lands conveyed to T. C. Patterson Trustee, by Cherokee Land Company, by its deed recorded in Book of Deeds "33" at page 328.
