All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the North side of Cleveland St. known and designated as lot #20 of the subdivision known as McDaniel Heights according to a Plat of the same recorded in Plat Book "G", at page 214 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Cleveland St. at corner of lot #21 and running thence with line of Lot #21 N. 20-14 E. 170 feet to pin; thence N. 69-46 W. 60 feet to pin at corner of lot #19; thence with line of Lot #19 S. 20-14 W. 170 feet to a pin on Cleveland St.; thence with Cleveland St. S. 69-46 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
