All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chicks Springs Township, about two miles west of the town of Greer, on the north side of the road leading from the Buncome Road to Suber's corn Mill, adjoining lands of I. P. Bow, Mrs. Will Hease and myself, and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed from O. O. Revision, said deed recorded in the office of the R. M.
