TITLE TO REAL ESTATESTATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,
Greenville County.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. R. Putman,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other valuable consideration Dollars,

to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Aner Putman

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Aner Putman All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situated, lying and being in the County of Greenville, state of South Carolina, in Oaklawn township, about seventeen miles from the city of Greenville, and being further described as follows:

Beginning with the corner of I. P. Jordan's land, on the line between K. S. Chandler and J. R. Putman land, thence S. thirty-two east 1570.7 ft. to a stone, corner of land conveyed by George Stone to H. E. Stone, later conveyed to Aner Putman, thence along this line N. 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. to the center of the pavement of the Augusta Road, thence northward along the center of the Augusta Road to a line between K. S. Chandler and J. R.

Putman, thence along this line to the beginning corner. This entire tract of land lies west of the Augusta Road, all of this piece of land to be conveyed to Aner Putman, except eight acres which is to be taken out in a square at the southwest corner of the above described tract.
