E. Hendrix, Talitha Reid, L. P. Hendrix, Fuller Hendrix, May Hargrove, Rossie Walden and Fannie Cooper;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the north side of the Finlay Bridge Road, and containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, and being the same lot or tract of land conveyed to P. J. Hendrix by N. L. Hoyt by a deed bearing date 22 day of August 1912, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Volume No. 21 of Deeds at page 74, For a more complete description by metes and bounds, see said deed, or see deed recorded in the same office in Book 1000, of Deeds at page 251.
