Lillie McAlister, her heirs and assigns.

All our undivided interest in and to that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Bates Township, County and State aforesaid, about one and one-half miles from Travelers Rest, S. C. on the Tigerville road, containing (18) Eighteen acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a stake in the Tigerville Road, thence with Mrs. A. D. Hart's line N. 14 1/2 W. 20.25 to a stone 0M; thence S. 70 1/4 W. 7.25 to stone 0M; thence S. 5 E. 10.66 to stone 0M; thence S. 1 1/2 W. 9.63 to stone in said Tigerville road; thence with said road N. 82 E. 2.50; thence with said road N. 77 E. 3.00; thence with said road N. 72 E. 5.37 to the beginning corner, as surveyed by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, June 13th, 1916, and bounded by lands of W. W. Benson; Mrs. A. D. Hart and the Tigerville Road, and being the same tract of land conveyed to our father by Earle Benson by deed recorded in the R. & C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 42, page 275, on the 31st day of January, 1918.
