All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, about two and one-half miles North West of the Town of Greenville, on the West side of the Gilbreath Mill Road (formerly called Mastella Road), adjoining lands of Baldy Bramlett, B. L. Smith, and tract number two of the estate of W. H. Smith, and being known and designated as tract number three on plat of W. H. Smith Estate, said plat prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, November 30th 1936, and being all of same tract conveyed to W. H. Smith by deed from W. P. Smith, recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in deed book 6 at page 356, and also being a part of the tract conveyed to W. H. Smith by deed from A. W. Hankins recorded in deed book 777 at page 374, and having the following courses and distances, to wit: -

Beginning on a point in the Gilbreath Mill Road, corner of tract number two, and runs thence N. 75-05' W. 1790 feet to a stake on branch, N. M.; thence down the said branch N. 11-30' E. 138.5 feet to a bend; thence N. 18-30' E. 100 feet to bend; thence N. 26-30' E. 151.3 feet to a bend and near the mouth of another branch; thence N. 8-45' W. 73 feet to a stake, C. M. on East side of the first named branch, B. L. Smith's corner; thence N. 64-36' E. 541.2 feet to a stone, C. M., thence N. 4-15' E. 132 feet to a stone, C. M., B. L. Smith's corner; thence S. 50-00' E. 1426 feet to a point in the Gilbreath Mill Road; thence S. 1-45' E. 326.5 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Twenty Four and 25/100 (24.25) Acres, more or less.
