All that certain tract parcel or lot of land lying and being in
 Greer Township and Greenville County and having the following metes and
 bounds and corners and distances. Beginning on a stake on the Few line,
 running thence with the Few line N 83° 7.68 E to an iron pin. Thence N 55° E
 1.89 to a point in road. Thence N 15 1/2 E 11.57 chains to a stone chance N 70° E.
 35.50 to an iron pin. Thence S 21 1/2 E 5.70 to a stake chance S 70 W. 30.80 to an
 iron pin. Thence S 4 1/2 E 3.12 to an iron pin. Thence S 62 W. 9.80 to an iron pin
 in the road - enter chance down said road S 22 E 2.40 to a pin chance S 62 W.
 5.83 to a stake the beginning corner and containing Thirty-one and Twenty
 Two one hundredth acre more or less (31.22) divided by Islands of Few and
 Lot #2 and 3 of the subdivision of J. S. Bonar Estate.
