(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*Edith Holightly and her heirs and assigns forever, all that piece parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid about four miles from the Greenville County Court House on the new Casley Bridge Road and known and designated as lot no. 4, as shown on a Plat of the property of P. J. Sentell made by Dalton and Reeves Engineers, in June 1934, and being more particularly described as follows:  
Beginning at an iron pin on Casley Bridge Road, joint corner of lots nos. 3 and 4, and running thence N. 28.55 W. 224 feet to an iron pin in corner of lots nos. 3 and 4; thence S. 51.35 W. 67.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 16.53 W. 223 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 16.53 W. 223 feet to an iron pin corner of a 12 foot driveway from Casley Bridge Road; thence N. 58.45 E. 112.8 feet to the beginning corner.*
