All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate,
lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Pickens Springs Town-
ship, adjoining lands of R. B. Vaughn, Brannon, and others, and being
known as lot No. 9 on a Scot showing the the sub-division of
the John T. Taylor lands and being the same lot conveyed to us by
John T. Taylor by deed bearing date May 15th 1919 and recorded in
the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol 51 at page 140,
and having the following courses and distances: Beginning on an
iron pin near R. B. Vaughn's on north side of Buncombe Road and
running thence N 30° 22' along the line of R. B. Vaughn to an
iron pin in center of National Highway; thence along the said
highway N 59° 15' E 440' to corner of lots nos. 1 and 2; thence N.
79° 50' E to angle in said highway, thence N. 89° 30' E. 454' to an
iron pin at corner of lots 2 & 3; thence S. 10° 15' E. 543' to an
