Charleston, a corporation chartered under the laws of the United States of America and having its principal place of business at Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand fifty 4 m 100 DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto G. E. White

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the subdivision known as Cherokee Park, and designated as Lot No. 1 of the E. C. Cass property, according to a revised plat of same made by C. M. Furman, May 1st, 1924, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "F", at page 227, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of Keowee Avenue, which iron pin is 05 feet from the Northeastern intersection of Saluda and Keowee Avenues, and running thence N. 62-32 W. 172 feet to an iron pin in the Southeastern side of a 16 foot alley; thence along the Southeastern side of said alley, N. 27-28 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, the rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 62-32 E. 172 feet to an iron pin in the line of Keowee Avenue; thence along the Northwestern side of Keowee Avenue, S. 27-28 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning, and being the same tract of land conveyed to the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, by E. C. Cass by deed dated June 6, 1929 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 138, page 270.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee, hereinafore named, and

heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, ~~and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.~~
