All that certain piece of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, near the Paris Mountain Road on Laurel Street and being known and designated as a part of Lots 1 and 2, on plat of the property of G. Dewey Syner, made by W. E. Dalton, Engineer, April 1923, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on Laurel Street at corner of property of American Spinning Company, and running thence along line of American Spinning Company property S. 33-54 W. 88.4 ft.; thence S. 56-06 E. 100 ft.; thence N. 33-54 E. 88.6 feet to Laurel Street; thence along Laurel Street N. 33-54 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
