All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Greenville Township, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, known and designated as lots # 8, 11, 12 and 13 in the section known as Nickeltown as shown on plat of divine property recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 11, bearing the same lots conveyed to the grantor herein by Mrs. M. M. Smith by deed dated October 14, 1930 and recorded in the R. M. C.
