to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinabove named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto.

Maurice M. Thompson, his heirs and assigns  
all that certain lot, parcel or tract of land in the  
City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina,  
in the South side of Nichols Street, having the  
following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at the corner of lot of Julia S. Charles (or  
formerly of Julia S. Charles), on the said street; thence  
west line of said Charles lot southwesterly 163 feet to a  
corner, thence N. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 41.4 feet to corner of lot on which C. Nellie Nowe now has an option; thence N. 28 E. about 145 feet  
to South side of Nichols Street, thence with Nichols Street,  
d. N. 78 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. about 42 feet to the beginning corner.

This deed conveys the Eastern half of the J. J. Robinson  
lot represented on City Map page 86 in Block 1 as lot  
no. 10, being one-half of the lot which was conveyed  
to the grantor, The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,  
by C. Irman, Master, deed bearing date January 6,  
1936, recorded in Deed Book 183, page 35, R. M. C.  
Office for said Greenville County. The courses in  
this deed are from the old survey as set forth in  
prior deeds in chain of title.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and him  
heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
grantee hereinabove named, and him  
heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

on this the Twenty-first day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine
