to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee or hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Charles P. Estration and Catina E. Estration.

All that lot of land situate on the south side of Coffee Street, in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, beginning at a stake 65.30 feet from the southwest corner of Coffee and formerly McBee Street, and running thence in a westernly direction with Coffee Street 60.85 feet to a stake; thence in a southwesternly direction with the cross fence 121-3/4 foot to the Elias Montgomery line; thence with said line in an Easternly direction 60.85 feet to a stake, and thence in a direct line 121- $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to the grantor herein by J. Inman, Master, by deed dated the 11th day of September, 1833, recorded in Volume 169, Page 133 in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance, Greenville County, South Carolina.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
