on the north side of the Franklin Road about 3 1/2 miles from the courthouse, of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of the Franklin Road and 108 feet easterly from a 15 ft. road and runs thence with said Franklin Road S. 81 E. 588 ft. to Langston's Creek; thence with said Langston's Creek N. 22 1/2 E. 344 1/2 ft. to bend; thence up Creek N. 28 E. 371.6 ft. to a corner on H. B. Tindal's line; thence with said Tindal's line N. 60 W. 620.6 ft. to an iron pin on the east side of 15 ft. road, thence with said 15 ft. road S. 27 1/2 W. 403.6 ft. to an iron pin on road; thence S. 65 E. 104 ft. to an iron pin 3x; thence S. 27-30 W. 400 ft. to an iron pin on Franklin Road, the beginning corner, and containing 10 acres, be the same more or less, and is all the land deeded to M. W. Bridges by Piedmont Savings & Investment Company by deed dated January, 1909, with the exception of one acre deeded to B. F. Edwards, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Ida Ward by D. M.
