KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

in consideration of the sum of *Two Hundred Seventy Five and no/100*

to me paid by *Carol W. Coons and Isobel Coons*

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said *Carol W. Coons and Isobel Coons*

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

near the City of Greenville, situate, lying and
being on the northern side of Finley Street, in a
subdivision known as Highland Terrace and being
known and designated as Lot no 18 Block "A"
according to a plat of said subdivision,
made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in October 1936,
not yet recorded, and having the following
metres and bounds, according to said plat.

Beginning at a point on the northern
side of Finley Street, joint southern corners of
Lots no 17 and 18 and running thence along
Finley Street N. 71-50 E. 50 feet to a point,
joint southern corners of Lots no 18 and 19;
running thence along the joint line of
Lots no 18 and 19 N. 18-10 E. 150 feet to a point,
joint northern corners of Lots no 19 and 18;
running thence along the rear line of Lot
no 18 S. 70-50 E. 50 feet to a point, joint
northern corners of Lots no 17 and 18;
running thence along the joint line of
Lots no 17 and 18 S. 18-10 E. 150 feet to the
point of beginning.

Subject, however, to the following building
restrictions:

1. No building shall be erected on the above
described property costing less than Three Thousand
(\$3000.00) Dollars.

2. No building shall be erected nearer to the
street than the building line which is
thirty (30) feet from the street which said property
faces.

3. The grantor agrees to hard surface Finley
avenue and place sewer and water lines
along said street within a reasonable time.
