All that piece or lot of land lying in Chick Springs Township on waters of Mountain Creek, adjoining land of Paris State Park, known as Lot No. 2 of sub-division of property of Louisa Sumerell with metes and bounds to-wit:-

Beginning at a stone corner of State Park and running thence S. 41 deg 25 min E. 59 1/4 ft. to a Red Oak; thence S. 9 deg. 25 min. E. 165 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 32 deg. 47 min W. 379.6 ft. to an iron pin (new Mark); thence N. 47 deg. 43 min W. 435 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 86 deg. 7 min W. 668 ft. to iron pin; thence S. 56 deg. 22 min W. 414 ft. to an iron pin (old Mark); thence N. 85 deg. 18 min W. 345.8 ft. to stake in old road; thence N. 6 deg. 12 min E. 143 ft. to iron pin; thence with boundary of State Park N. 63 deg. E. 1617 ft. to beginning corner; and according to survey by T. T. Dill Sept. 1939 contains 18.56 acres, more or less. The above described tract is part of land deeded by W. L.
