All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicks Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

lying on the North side of the new U. S. super-highway No. 29, about three-fourths miles West from the incorporate limits of Greer, and being all of lot No. 9 of the C. L. King lands, as shown on a plat thereof prepared by S. C. Moon, Surveyor, dated April 1941, which plat is on record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. Said lot fronts on said new super-highway 50 feet and has a uniform depth of 195 feet, and is bounded by lot No. 10, Bass, said new super-highway and others.

Also, all of that other lot situate and being in Chicks Springs Township of Greenville County, adjoining the above described lot and being all of lot No. 10 of the C. L. King lands; as shown on a plat of the same prepared by S. C. Moon, Surveyor, dated April, 1941, said plat being on record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, said lot lying on the North side of new U. S. super-highway No. 29, about three-fourths miles West from the Town of Greer, fronting on said highway 50 feet and having a uniform depth of 195 feet. Said lot is bounded by lands of Palmer Dillard, Bass, lot No. 9, said highway and others.
