POWER OF ATTORNEY.

Gilreath, of Greenville, S. C., as my true and lawful attorney, with full power and authority, in my name and stead, to demand, collect and receive all sums due to me.

Giving and granting, by these presents, unto Margaret C. Gilreath, as my attorney, full power and authority:

(a) To sell and convey any and all property owned by me, both real and personal, upon such terms and prices as to her may seem best, in her discretion, and to execute any and all deeds, or other instruments of conveyance, in my name and stead.

(b) To endorse, deposit and collect any checks payable to me, and to draw checks on my bank account in my name and stead.

(c) And, generally, to do all and every other act and thing in my name and stead, as fully as I could do if personally present, and I do hereby ratify and confirm all the acts and doings of Margaret C. Gilreath, as my attorney in the premises.

(d) It is understood that this power of attorney shall remain in full force and effect until the same is revoked in writing, and in the event this instrument is recorded, it shall remain in full force and effect until the same is duly cancelled of record.
