dated May 7, 1940.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

George Norwood, as Trustee for Wilkins Norwood under a Trust Indenture dated May 7, 1940, His
Successors and Assigns for ever, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, at the Southwest corner of Gordon Avenue and Link Street, near the City of
Greenville, being a portion of Lots #8 and #9 as shown on plat of property of W. D. Workman, record-
ed in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at page 288, and being described as
follows:

Beginning at a stake at the Southwest corner of Gordon Avenue and Link Street and
running thence with Gordon Avenue S. 80-08 W. 79.05 feet to a stake; thence S. 10-49 W. 135 feet
to a point; thence in a easternly direction approximately 155 feet to a point on Link Street which
point is 140 feet from the intersection of the Southwest corner of Gordon Avenue and Link Street;
thence with Link Street N. 20-57 W. 140 feet to point of beginning; and being the same property
conveyed to the grantor by deed of The Suburban Development Company dated April 4, 1940 and record-
ed in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 221, at page 183.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, in Ward Six of the City of Greenville on the north side of Watts
Avenue (formerly Lucille Avenue), and designated as Lot #12 of Block "G" on plat of Chapin Springs
Land Company, recorded in Plat Book E, page 41, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Watts Avenue at corner of Lot #4 and
running thence with Watts Avenue N. 88 E. 50 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot #11; thence with
the line of lots Nos. 11 and 10 N. 2 W. 130 feet to iron pin joint corner of Lots Nos. 7, 9, and
10; thence with the line of Lot #7, S. 88 W. 50 feet to iron pin in line of lot #6; thence with
a line of lots Nos. 6, 5, and 4 S. 2 E. 130 feet to the beginning corner; and being the same lot
of land conveyed to the grantor by deed of Henry F. McCamish dated June 28, 1941 and recorded
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 234, at page 400.
