Heyward Mahon, Jr. and Elizabeth W. Mahon, their Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the West side of Altamont Road (sometimes referred to as Old Hotel Road), on Paris Mountain in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to plat of property of the grantor, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, June 1925, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Altamont Road at the Northeast corner of property now or formerly of W. B. Ellis, and running thence with said Ellis line N. 79-02 W. 454.5 feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly of P. Ed. Hudson and others; thence with said Hudson line N. 25-50 E. 1470.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 86-21 E. 200 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the West side of Altamont Road; thence with the West side of Altamont Road in a general Southerly direction 1500 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

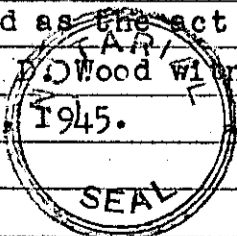
